Beginning the program is an introduction of staff, sponsors, special guests, and an address from the executive director, followed by this year's Opening Night Film, Jason Reitman's, *Men, Women, and Children*.

SCREENING VENUES

THE MUSIC HALL

The Music Hall is a landmark historic theater widely considered a cinema treasure across the nation. This meticulously restored 1878 Victorian theater features a 900 seat auditorium and the elegant and eclectic Founder's Lobby Lounge and Bar.





THE MUSIC HALL LOFT

A more intimate sister venue of the historic theater, the Music Hall Loft seats 106 with gourmet food and cocktails that can be taken to each seat.

THE MOFFATT-LADD HOUSE

One of America's finest Georgian Mansions, the home was built between 1760-1763. For NHFF screenings the Moffatt-Ladd Coach House seats 70 and has been retrofitted with state-of-the-art projection equipment for a screening venue that is truly unique.





SEACOAST REPERTORY THEATER

A screening venue on the harbor, the Seacoast Rep seats 195 and is a beautiful cultural center hosting the majority of the city's live theater productions throughout the year.

Travel is from South Station/Logan Airport (Boston) or P.A.B.T. (NYC) to Pease International Tradeport Terminal Portsmouth, NH. Travel time to and from NYC is approximately 5 hours, travel time to and from Boston is approximately 1 hour.



NYC PASSENGERS

Anyone looking to book must email NHFF Hospitality representative Christine Hunt (hospitality@ nhfilmfestival.com) with their preferred schedule to reserve their ticket. NYC tickets are booked on a first come, first serve basis, so please reserve your ticket as soon as possible. (Eligible travel dates are Wednesday October 15th-Monday October 20th)

BOSTON PASSENGERS

C&J does not reserve seats on Boston runs. Seating is first come, first serve, but to utilize the free ticket, you must book an unscheduled round-trip ticket in advance for use during the weekend. Anyone looking to book must email NHFF Hospitality representative Christine Hunt (hospitality@nhfilmfestival.com). (Eligible travel dates are Wednesday October 15th-Monday October 20th) The Pease International Terminal is approximately 3 miles from downtown Portsmouth where the festival takes place.

All other travel to the festival are the responsibility of the filmmaker unless other arrangements have already been made.
